




After last week's tutorial, I decided to pursue the line of enquiry in to the stickers I noticed between all the shops on Wood Green High St.

I decided to walk the whole stretch of road between Turnpike Lane and Wood Green, capturing each cluster of stickers along the route on both sides of the street.



The stickers all seem to be advertising shutter install and repair businesses.






After taking all the photos I was interested by how they looked visually in the camera roll on my phone.
